



The Value we will be reflecting upon this term is 'Faith'.

Maths

This term in Maths we are beginning by learning about number and place value. We will also be working on doubling and making number bonds. In mental calculations we will be using number bonds to 10. We will be learning to read and write number names. We will continue to develop our knowledge of shapes and their properties by using Venn and Carroll diagrams.

History

We will study the stories of Guy Fawkes and Ruby Bridges. We will develop historical questions and make narratives and accounts of the events.

R.E.

This half term we will first be looking at the Christian festival of Harvest. Using the Southwark Diocese syllabus for R.E. we will be asking the question:

What Responsibility Has God Given People For Taking Care of Creation?

The children will be exploring Creation and looking at ways to look after the world that God has created for us. This links well to our ECO work as a whole school.

English

We will continue to develop our phonic knowledge by studying longer words with adjacent consonants and we will begin to learn a range of new sounds. We will be learning to retell a story in detail, sequencing the main parts. We will further develop sentence writing and short narratives with traditional tales.
