## Our new school milk scheme

School milk is excellent as a mid-morning drink. It provides a nutritional boost and keeps children hydrated between breakfast and lunch, helping them to concentrate and learn. From half term we are introducing a new system for you to order morning milk for your child through Cool Milk.

The new milk scheme is available to all of our pupils in all year groups. By registering your child with the school milk scheme, they will receive a 189ml (third of a pint) carton of semi-skimmed cow's milk every day, delivered fresh and chilled during morning playtime.

School milk is free for under-5s, and for over-5s it is available at a subsidised\* price of 22p per day (approx. £15 per term). If your child is entitled to (means-tested) Free School Meals s/he is also entitled to free milk through the School Payment Scheme. Please contact Mrs Frost in the school office if you think your child may be entitled to this.

### How to register

#### If your child is under five:

- Register online at [www.coolmilk.com](http://www.coolmilk.com) or complete a registration form available from the school office
- Register by a Tuesday at 5pm for your child's free milk to start the following week
- Free milk will continue until the Friday before your child's fifth birthday. You will receive a payment request four weeks before their birthday - if you wish your child to continue to receive school milk, simply make a payment

#### If your child is five or older:

- Register and pay online at [www.coolmilk.com](http://www.coolmilk.com)
- Alternatively, fill in a registration form available from the school office – once Cool Milk has processed your form, you will receive a payment request
- You can pay Cool Milk either online, over the phone or at a local PayPoint in half-termly, termly or annual instalments.
- Please pay by a Tuesday at 5pm for your child's milk to start the following week
