MONDAY YOUNG ARTS & CRAFTERS CLUB : SPRING TERM 2025

We are delighted to tell you that our Arts and Crafts Club will return in the spring term.

The club is run by Jane O'Keefe, owner of Woodmouse Arts & Crafts. Jane offers fun, creative small group sessions which give the children weekly opportunities to try out, and have fun with, a range of media. The emphasis is on learning and practising new skills rather than producing a polished end result!

Term dates: Mon 13 Jan to Mon 24 Marc 2025 [excl 17 Feb] – 10 weeks

Sessions will take place in the Dragonflies Classroom from 3.15 – 4.15pm on Monday afternoons. The club is open to children in Years R - 2 this term and priority will be given to those that have not previously had an opportunity to join. Your child will need a named apron (an old shirt would be perfect) or an old t-shirt to change into.

The cost of the club is £7.50 per session paid termly in advance and includes the cost of all materials. Places are **very limited** so please complete the attached form and return to the school office as soon as possible with payment. Booking will be confirmed when payment is received via either BACS or at school office.

A register will be taken for each session and the children will be collected from the classroom at the end of the school day and taken to Art Club. Please notify the class teacher in the morning if someone other than yourself will be collecting them after the club and also notify us if your child will not be attending the session for any reason so that this information can be passed on to Jane. Please collect your child promptly and in person at 4.15pm from the Dragonflies classroom.
